PCO began life in 2018, in response to the realisation that there was nowhere locally for adults to play orchestral instruments together, unless they could play at a very advanced standard. We now have fifty members aged between fourteen and ninety years of age, with an equally wide range of musical experience. Some members play instruments not usually heard in an orchestra, including saxophones, bass clarinet and bass ukulele. Although named Peterborough Community Orchestra, our members are spread across a radius of twenty miles around the city, including Crowland.
